

**Ordinance #84

**AN ORDINANCE OPTING-OUT OF
THE REQUIREMENTS OF
MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593**

Whereas, on May 12, 2016, Governor Mark Dayton signed into law the creation and regulation of temporary family health care dwellings, codified at Minn Stat. § 462.3593, which permit and regulate temporary family health care dwellings;

Whereas, subdivision 9 of Minn. Stat. §462.3593, allows cities to ‘opt-out’ of those regulations;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE WILSON, ORDAINS TO OPT-OUT OF MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593:

Pursuant to authority granted by Minnesota Statutes, Section 462.3593, subdivision 9, the City of Lake Wilson opts-out of the requirements of Minn. Stat. §462.3593, which defines and regulates Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings.

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication.
